

RECIPES FROM CMA START STUDIO

Play Dough

2 cups of water
2 cups of flour
1/2 cup salt
4 tablespoons cream of tartar
2 tablespoons vegetable oil
liquid water color paint
or food coloring

1. Combine and stir dry ingredients
2. Add water. Stir until lumps disappear.
3. Add vegetable oil. Stir
4. Add paint/food coloring. Stir. (Have fun!)
5. Cook and stir continually over medium heat for 15-20 minutes or until dough is no longer sticky.
6. Dump dough out, knead, and let cool. Once cool, store in airtight container for longevity.

Flubber

2 cups of school glue
3 cups of water
2 tablespoons of Borax*
(non-toxic cleaning agent)
liquid water color paint
or food coloring

1. Mix glue and water until smooth
2. Add paint/food coloring. Stir. (Have fun!)
3. Dissolve 2 tablespoons of borax in about 1/3 cup of hot water
4. Pour borax solution into glue-water mixture in circular motion
5. Mix with hands in circular motion until Flubber forms and water is mostly absorbed.
6. Stir in airtight container for longevity.

Should Flubber get on clothing or hair, WHITE VINEGAR will help remove it.

* **BORAX**, or sodium tetraborate decahydrate, is a non-toxic cleaning agent composed of sodium, boron, oxygen, and water. It is not to be consumed although it is non-toxic. Brands such as **20 Mule Team** are available in the cleaning aisle of your local grocery store.
